The **Certified Firefighter Test (CFT)** is a job knowledge test designed for selecting candidates who have completed their state Firefighter I certification. Many agencies are also requiring state EMT certification, which is why clients may elect to use the Brady's EMT portion in addition to the Firefighting Essentials portion. This test is appropriate for candidates with advanced entry qualifications and EMT certifications.
